7 NEW HOLES

Hole by Hole Strategy Summary

HOLE #2: PAR 5: 520 YARDS

This par five poses an immediate challenge with a demanding tee shot. Water and bunker guard the left side of the fairway. Good players will likely find the temptation to go for the green in two shots irresistible. A small bunker, strategically placed on the right side of the second landing area, along with a greenside bunker may cause even the aggressive player to think twice about such an approach.

HOLE #3: PAR 3: 185 YARDS

The lake paralleling the left side of this par three gives the impression that the hole is more difficult than the demand that is presented. For the player that blocks a tee shot right and away from the lake, the generous area short and right of the green will leave a fairly routine shot to the flagstick. The subtly contoured green will require a deft putting touch.

HOLE #4: PAR 4: 445 YARDS

This very long par four will require two very well struck shots in order to have a reasonable chance for a birdie. A tee shot within the ample landing area will require the player to hit a long iron / hybrid wood to this narrow green. Par will be a good number on this golf hole. This modestly guarded green will prove to be a receptive target for the reasonably well struck golf shot.

HOLE #5: PAR 3: 220 YARDS

What you see is what you get on this long par three. The bunkers on both sides of the green demand a precise tee shot in order to score a par or better.

HOLE #6: PAR4: 400 YARDS

This mid length par four plays slightly uphill. A tee shot struck to the generous landing area will then present to the player an approach to a large green. The subtly shaped, three tiered green is void of bunkers, but is fronted by soft swales which may present the player with a difficult recovery shot.

HOLE #7: PAR 4: 300 YARDS

This short par four will play more difficult than the yardage indicates. Aggressive will be tempted to drive to the green. Congratulations to those who succeed. A shot that is long or even slightly to the left will likely find the bottom of a wash that defines the entire left side of the hole. The conservative play would be a tee shot to the wide and receptive landing area, leaving a short pitch shot to a small undulating green guarded by two bunkers.

HOLE #8: PAR 5: 510 YARDS

This medium length par five must be navigated carefully in order to score well. While the tee shot is not particularly demanding, the approach shot to the green will require good judgement and skill in going for the green in two. The large, modest putting surface is guarded by a pond on the left and a small bunker on the right. Conservative play here may not offer the opportunity for an eagle, but will likely yield a par or birdie.
